

Patio SPIRAL HANGERS

SIZE: Each is 4½" x 7" (10.8 cm x 17.8 cm), not including hanger.

MATERIALS FOR ONE:

- ½ sheet each of main and contrasting color 7-count plastic canvas
- Size 1 snap swivel (available at sporting goods stores)
- ½ yd. [0.3 m] of monofilament fishing line
- Worsted-weight or plastic canvas yarn; for amount see Color Key.

STITCH KEY:

- A Spoke Attachment

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

A: For spiral pieces, cut two (one from each color) according to graph.

B: For ends, cut two from desired color according to graph.

STITCHING INSTRUCTIONS:
(See Stitch Guide on pages 4 & 5.)

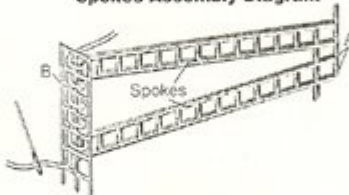
NOTE: A pieces are unworked; for spiral, hold A pieces together and work through both thicknesses as one piece when joining to ends.

1: Cut yarn in half. Using one strand and Long Stitch, work one B according to graph, attaching spokes at indicated holes along one

side of spiral according to Spokes Assembly Diagram (**NOTE:** Spokes will spread out and twist to form a spiral as you work.); secure yarn ends. Repeat on opposite side of spiral with remaining strand and B piece.

2: To hang, tie one end of fishing line to ♦ hole through both thicknesses as indicated; tie opposite end of line to snap swivel (see photo). ☺
